

This week's animal is the sea turtle. Sea turtles are one of the Earth's more ancient animals. There are seven species of sea turtles and they have been around for 110 million years; this is all the way back when the dinosaurs were around. Other types of turtles can pull their head and legs all the way inside their shells to hide away from danger.

Sea turtles cannot do this. This is because their shell is made out of bone and cartilage and is made for swimming under water.

Sea turtles eat a variety of things. This usually depends on the species of the sea turtle, but they vary from herbivorous, carnivorous, and omnivorous. The jaw of the sea turtle shows what kind of diet they have. Green sea turtles have a finely serrated jaw that allows them for a vegetarian diet. The most common items they eat are jellyfish, seaweed, crabs, shrimp, sponges, snails, algae, and mollusks.

Six of the seven species of sea turtles are endangered by humans. Many of them are in danger when they travel the seas, mainly because of fishing. An average of 4,600 sea turtles die each year because of fishing. They can be wrapped in hooks or bait lines set for fish and drown. They are well adapted to the ocean, but they need air to survive. There has been a 90% reduction of sea turtles because of accidental catching since 1990.

The story mode in "Madden NFL 18" is called "Longshot," and it's easily the most dramatic change to this year's game. Playing it often feels surreal considering what "Madden" games are usually like.
