

Distance Learning Science Class

Materials needed at home:

- Any device with internet access (Computers/Laptops are preferred, but I will try to make every assignment able to be completed on a cell phone, tablet, etc.)
- Science Interactive Notebook
- Scissors
- Glue or tape
- Colored Pencils, markers, or Crayons

How we will be communicating during this time:

1. Google Classroom:
 - **Daily assignments-** Each weekday (excluding Spring Break), I will post the day's assignment. This could consist of reviewing certain slides in the PowerPoint, writing notes into the interactive notebook, and completing the corresponding activity. Assignments will also include web-based activities.
 - **PowerPoints-** I will be posting the PowerPoint for the unit we will currently be covering. Each day, I will post the slide numbers that need to be studied for that day, if this applies.
 - **Videos for extra help-** I will post additional resources to help support the topic that is being covered that day (if it seems to be a difficult topic)
 - **Turning in assignments-** All assignments will be turned in through google classroom. I will post assignments, due dates, and amount of points.
 - Example: Take a picture of activity completed in your notebook
 - NOTE: Because assignments will be turned in through here, please have the account in the STUDENT'S names.
 - **Quizzes/Tests-** If we are out longer than April 6th, we will need to take quizzes/tests on google classroom. This will appear similar to how an assignment will look on google classroom. Quizzes will be multiple choice questions. Tests will be more of a short answer/essay format

2. Zoom:

- On Tuesdays and Thursdays, I will be available for live video chat/questions from 1:20-2:15 pm. This will be a time for students to ask questions about the following day's notes/activities. This will not be an "instruction" time, rather, simply a question/answer session (if needed by the student). You will receive the link to sign in from Google Classroom. This is not a requirement to attend these meetings if you are unable to attend for some reason. Questions can still be asked anytime by google classroom or my email below.

3. Planbook:

- The assignments will also be posted on planbook.com. and linked on the school website under the digital learning tab. However, this will not be my main source of communication. Please check google classroom every weekday!!

4. iNow

- All grades will still be posted on iNow. Please check this regularly to make sure students are up to date on these assignments.
 - Note: Google Classroom has a grade option, but this may not be an accurate representation of their grade. Accurate grades will be found on iNow!
